Applications Listed on Website. All exhibits that have been accepted are now listed on the exhibition's website at www.london2020.co/exhibits/. There is a total of almost 900 exhibits shown. One innovation at London 2020 is that the first page of each display is viewable on the web. Although all of the exhibits are included, it is a time-consuming task to get the images organised, so please be patient if one of the ones you want to view is not loaded just yet as our volunteers are working as fast as they can! There are some missing from our files, so if you are an exhibitor and you have not yet sent a copy of your first page to us, please do so now to commissionergeneral@london2020.co.

Admission to the Exhibition. As many of you will already understand, London 2020 has no underlying benefactor and the Organising Committee have worked very hard to keep the finances under control. Despite this, admission to the exhibition for visitors will be free on all days other than the first. On Saturday 2 May, admission for the general public will be £10; children under 18 will be free. Exhibitors, Patrons and Supporters are of course exempt from this fee; they should collect their badges etc from the special desk located on the first-floor landing at the top of the escalator. *[Translation for our American friends: collect from the second-floor landing at the top of the moving stairway.]*

As with many large international exhibitions, we expect that there will be a queue on the first morning – there certainly was for London 2010 and London 2015! Please do come prepared with **£10 in Sterling cash** to buy your ticket: this will make the whole process as quick as possible. Entrance will be from the front doors, and then at ground level into the exhibition halls.

Volunteers Sought. The whole of the organisation of London 2020 is being undertaken by volunteers. We have a good number already – but we need more!

We specifically need people to help mount / dismount the exhibits on Thursday 30 April (all day), Friday 1 May (all day), Tuesday 5 May (afternoon and evening) and Saturday 9 May (afternoon and evening).
