### First Day Tickets Now Available

#### First Day Tickets

As with many FIP international exhibitions, visitors to the exhibition on the first day will be required to pay an entry fee of £10. Entry on all other days will be free.

Tickets can be purchased online at [www.london2022.co/london-2022-first-day-entry-tickets](http://www.london2022.co/london-2022-first-day-entry-tickets). The website allows you to pay either by PayPal or by credit card. Tickets will be emailed to you and can either be printed or presented at the door on a mobile phone to enter the show. Each ticket will have a unique reference number included which will prevent copied tickets being used.

It will be possible to purchase tickets on the door, but we anticipate that there will be queues.
